APPEARING REMOTELY IN JUVENILE COURT

Juvenile matters are confidential, and most proceedings are not open to the public. Only parties entitled to be present will be allowed into the Zoom meeting. If the hearing is not open to the public, you must be in a location that is private so that others cannot hear or see the hearing.

THIRTY MINUTES BEFORE YOUR HEARING:

- Download the Zoom app for your smartphone or tablet from the App/Play store.
- For computers or laptops, go to www.zoom.us/download
- Use the Test Meeting feature in advance of your hearing date.

- YOU MAY NOT RECORD ANY COURT PROCEEDINGS. Recording of court proceedings held by video or teleconference, including screen shots or any other form of audio or visual recording is strictly prohibited.
