3 D. Any electronic document submitted for filing, received by the court between 12 a.m.  
4 and 11:59:59 p.m. on a court day, shall be deemed filed as of that day, as set forth in *Code of Civil*  
5 *Procedure* §1010.6(b)(3). Any electronic document(s) submitted for filing, received by the court on  
6 a non-court day, will be deemed filed on the next court day. This rule concerns only the method and  
7 effective date of filing; any document that is electronically filed must satisfy all other legal filing  
8 deadlines and requirements. This rule also does not affect any statutory or court ordered  
9 requirements that a document be filed by a set date.


10 E. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or these rules, the following documents  
11 shall not be electronically submitted and/or filed by a party or user:

- 12 1. Will, codicil or testamentary trust;
- 13 2. Bond or undertaking;
- 14 3. Any order with an original judicial officer's signature;
- 15 4. Out-of-State Commission;
- 16 5. Abstract of Judgment;
- 17 6. Writ of Execution;
- 18 7. Confidential document(s) lodged conditionally under seal;
- 19 8. Certificate of Facts Re Unsatisfied Judgment;
- 20 9. Family Law Request for Entry of Default and the Notice of Entry of Judgment;
- 21 10. Letters of Administration;
- 22 11. Affidavit Re Real Property of Small Value (Probate); and,
- 23 12. Any paper document ordered by the court to be filed in the clerk's office.

24 This order shall expire on July 2, 2018, unless extended by the court.
