

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
APPOINTING TEMPORARY JUDGE
UNDER CALIFORNIA RULES OF
COURT, RULE 2.810(D)

Kevin Staker, attorney at law, is hereby appointed under the exception provided in *California Rules of Court*, rule 2.810(d), to serve on October 14, 2020, as a temporary judge of the Superior Court of California, County of Ventura in all cases assigned pursuant to stipulation as provided in Article 6, section 21 of the California Constitution.

The court finds extraordinary circumstances exist for the appointment. The extraordinary circumstances are that Mr. Staker has served as a temporary judge for several years and has previously participated in the required continuing education. As of May 4, 2020, it has been three years since Mr. Staker participated in the mandatory bench conduct and demeanor training. However, given the current COVID-19 pandemic and the need for socially distancing, the court has not been able to provide or conduct the training. Mr. Staker meets all other qualifications to serve as a temporary judge and the conditions for use of a court-appointed temporary judge are met, as set forth in *California Rules of Court*, rule 10.742.
