

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
APPOINTING TEMPORARY JUDGE  
UNDER CALIFORNIA RULES OF  
COURT, RULE 2.810(D)

Cristian Arrieta, attorney at law, is hereby appointed under the exception provided in *California Rules of Court*, rule 2.810(d), to serve on June 25, 2021 as a temporary judge of the Superior Court of California, County of Ventura in all cases assigned pursuant to stipulation as provided in Article 6, section 21 of the California Constitution.

The court finds extraordinary circumstances exist for the appointment. The extraordinary circumstances are that Mr. Arrieta has served as a temporary judge in past years and has previously participated in the required continuing education. As of May 4, 2020, it has been three years since Mr. Arrieta participated in the mandatory bench conduct and demeanor training. However, given the current COVID-19 pandemic and the need for socially distancing, the court has not been able to provide or conduct the training. Mr. Arrieta is qualified to serve under *California Rules of Court*, rule 2.812(a).
