David A. Esquibias, attorney at law, is hereby appointed under the exception provided in California Rules of Court, rule 2.810(d), to serve on August 18, 2022, as a temporary judge of the Superior Court of California, County of Ventura in all cases assigned pursuant to stipulation as provided in Article 6, section 21 of the California Constitution.

The court finds extraordinary circumstances exist for the appointment. The extraordinary circumstances are that Mr. Esquibias has served as a temporary judge in past years and has previously participated in the required continuing education. Mr. Esquibias has not completed all of the currently required elements of continuing education, although he has completed "Bench Conduct and Demeanor" offered by the court in November 2021. A number of local attorneys who are qualified to serve as temporary judges previously committed to providing pro tem coverage for the court's calendars in Department J6 to assist with a planned judicial absence between August 22, 2022, and September 9, 2022. As a result, those attorneys are unavailable to assist this week during the unexpected medical absence of the judicial officer in Department J6. Mr. Esquibias is available to assist the court on August 18, 2022, and is qualified to serve


