- 2. If you do not find availability, check every day, throughout the day, at both Ventura and Oxnard locations.
- 3. Disregard the message "No times in [month]." *The entire month is not already booked*. You can still make an appointment but you can only make it 7 days in advance.
- 4. We also receive many cancellations, so litigants are strongly encouraged to check every day, several times per day, for availability.

### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT

#### WHAT SHOULD I HAVE AVAILABLE?

- \* Valid identification
- \* Case number (if there's a case already filed)
- \* Pen (black or blue)
- \* All documents related to your case including copy of last Court Orders.
- \* If married and starting a new divorce/legal separation: Copy of your marriage certificate.
- \* If there are children and starting a new case or need help with final judgment: Copies of children's birth certificates.
- \* Blank No. 10 (Letter Size) envelopes and 7 forever stamps if coming in for final judgment.

#### ONLY NEED FORMS?

If you only need forms and not assistance from the Self-Help Center, there are Form Packets that may be downloaded from the Court's website:

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: If it is a new case, make sure to use <u>complete</u> <u>legal names</u> for all parties and children. Do not forget or abbreviate middle names.

Family, children or friends *may not accompany* you to your scheduled appointment unless previously approved by a Family Law staff member or unless they are with you to interpret for you.
