Reduction in Court Reporter Services

Pursuant to Administrative Order 22.13, beginning May 2, 2022, the Ventura Superior Court will <u>no</u> longer provide court reporters for the following types of proceedings:

<u>Civil</u> – case settlements placed on the record; Asset Forfeiture; Harassment; Elder/Dependent Adult Abuse; Workplace Violence; Private Postsecondary School Violence; Gun Violence Restraining Orders; and Petitions for Order Prohibiting Abuse or Program Misconduct.

<u>Family Law</u> – case settlements placed on the record; Request for Orders; Ex Partes; and Domestic Violence Restraining Orders.

Probate – all matters.

<u>Juvenile</u> – Status Conferences for Termination of Parental Rights (T) cases.

Any party may arrange at their own expense for a reporter to be present at a hearing listed above. A party that has been granted a fee waiver may make a written request for a court reporter, in advance, for a hearing listed above. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 2.956(c) for more information).
