Superior Court of California, County of Ventura Implementation of e-Delivery

Effective March 15, 2018 (Revised 2/27/18)

Effective March 15, 2018, e-Delivery, a service that will allow for the electronic submission of filing documents in Civil, Small Claims, Family Law and Probate cases, will be available on the Court's website at www.ventura.courts.ca.gov.

Upon the implementation of e-Delivery, the Ventura Superior Court will **no** longer accept fax filings and will discontinue use of Official Payments as a fax filing vendor. Documents can still be filed in person at the filing window.

The Court will hold Brown Bag Lunch meetings for attorneys/bar association members during which specific information, including a demonstration of the e-Delivery service, will be provided. Legal assistants, secretaries and attorney services are welcome to attend.
