CIVIL GRAND JURY APPLICATION DEADLINE EXTENDED

Applications for the 2020-2021 Civil Grand Jury are being sought by Superior Court of California, County of Ventura. The deadline to submit an application has been extended to Thursday, April 30, 2020. Applications postmarked by this date will be accepted.

To be considered for nomination to the Grand Jury, you must be a citizen of the United States, be 18 years of age or older, be in possession of your natural faculties, of ordinary intelligence, of sound judgment and of good character, and have been a resident of Ventura County for at least one year.

The Civil Grand Jury serves the citizens of Ventura County by investigation of County government and Special Districts. Principal functions of the Grand Jury include review of public complaints, investigation of County government agencies, inquiry into management of public prisons within the County, investigation of special districts of the county and city government, involvement in fiscal or management audits, and preparation of reports on investigated matters.

Service on the Civil Grand Jury is for a period of one year commencing July 1. 2020 through June 30, 2021 and usually involves 30 hours per week.
