ASSISTANT PRESIDING JUDGE KEVIN G. DeNOCE RECEIVES PUBLIC SAFETY AWARD

Ventura Superior Court Assistant Presiding Judge Kevin G. DeNoce has been selected as one of the recipients of the Oxnard Knights of Columbus Public Safety Award for 2022. The award was presented at the organization's Public Safety Night held on June 29, 2022, at the Knights of Columbus Hall, Council 750, in Oxnard.

Each year, the Oxnard Knights of Columbus recognize and honor men and women from law enforcement, the military, fire protection, and the judiciary for their service to our community and country.

Judge DeNoce is the Assistant Presiding Judge for Ventura County. He was first appointed to the bench as a Commissioner in 2007 and appointed as a Judge in 2008. Judge DeNoce has presided over more than 500 criminal and civil jury trials. He has served as the Supervising Judge for the Civil Division and served in the Criminal and Family Law Divisions. Judge DeNoce was awarded and named "Judge of the Year" by the Ventura County Trial Lawyers Association in 2017. Judge DeNoce is a former Senior Deputy District Attorney, former instructor at the Sheriff's Academy, and had two cases he handled as an attorney result in nationally published books.

Prior to his appointment to the bench, Judge DeNoce was a sole practitioner at the Law Offices of Kevin G. DeNoce and a partner in the Law Offices of Andrade & DeNoce, LLP. From 1987 to 1996, he served as a prosecuting attorney with the Ventura County District Attorney's Office, where he was the supervising attorney for the Appellate Division from 1992 to 1996 and a Senior Deputy District Attorney from 1994 to 1996.

Judge DeNoce earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Colorado at Boulder and law degree from Pepperdine University School of Law.
