A party and a person entitled by law to be present at the hearing may appear either:

No other person will be allowed into the courtroom but may be allowed to appear remotely using the Zoom link.

THIRTY MINUTES BEFORE YOUR HEARING:

- Download the Zoom app for your smartphone or tablet from the App/Play store.

- Use the Test Meeting feature in advance of your hearing date.
