

APPEARANCES FOR REQUEST FOR ORDER  
HEARINGS IN FAMILY LAW CASES

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
NO. 20.43

Due to the on-going COVID-19 pandemic and continued increase in COVID cases in Ventura County, the court continues to balance the needs of litigants to access to the courts to resolve cases, with efforts to protect the health and safety of court users, employees, and judicial officers.

**THEREFORE, GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, THIS COURT ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

All Request for Order hearings, beginning on January 4, 2021 shall be conducted remotely through the Zoom platform, as authorized by *California Rules of Court*, Emergency Rule 3.

The parties and counsel are to follow the procedures set out in the "Notice: AS OF JANUARY 4, 2021, ALL REQUEST FOR ORDER APPEARANCES ARE BY ZOOM," (hereinafter "Notice") which includes the instructions for remote appearances and must be served on the responding party. The Notice is incorporated herein and made a part of this order. The Notice is available on the court's website at [www.ventura.courts.ca.gov](http://www.ventura.courts.ca.gov) and shall remain in effect, until further order of the court.

1 All parties and counsel are prohibited from providing the Zoom address(es) to any third  
2 party. Only parties and counsel will be allowed into the Zoom hearing. All public and non-  
3 confidential proceedings are available through live stream at  
4 [http://www.ventura.courts.ca.gov/live\\_stream.html](http://www.ventura.courts.ca.gov/live_stream.html).


5 There shall be no recording of any of the court proceedings, other than by the assigned  
6 official court reporter. Any unofficial recording of the court proceedings held by video or  
7 teleconference, including screen shots or any other form of audio or visual recording is strictly  
8 prohibited without prior permission of the judicial officer presiding over the matter.

9 If a party is unable to appear by Zoom the party must appear in person and follow the  
10 procedure set out on the Notice.

11 THIS ORDER SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT, UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE AND MAY BE  
12 AMENDED OR REVOKED, AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.
